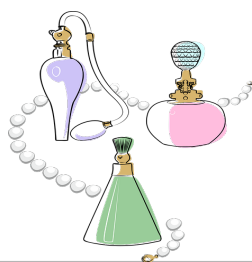

Are you the person to lead a

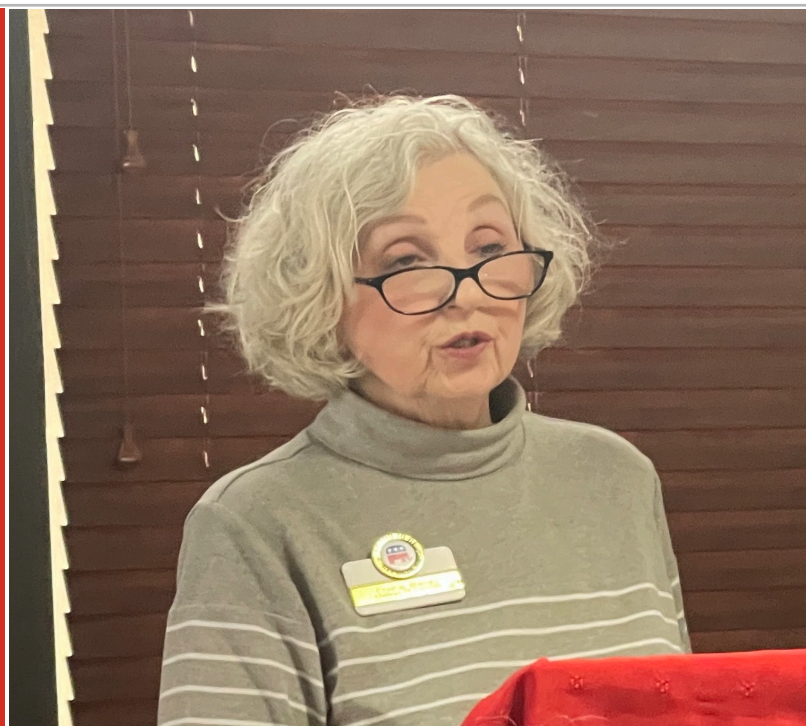
